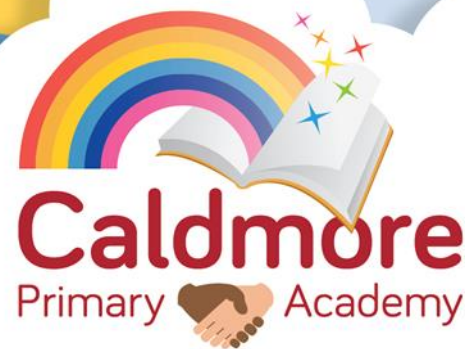

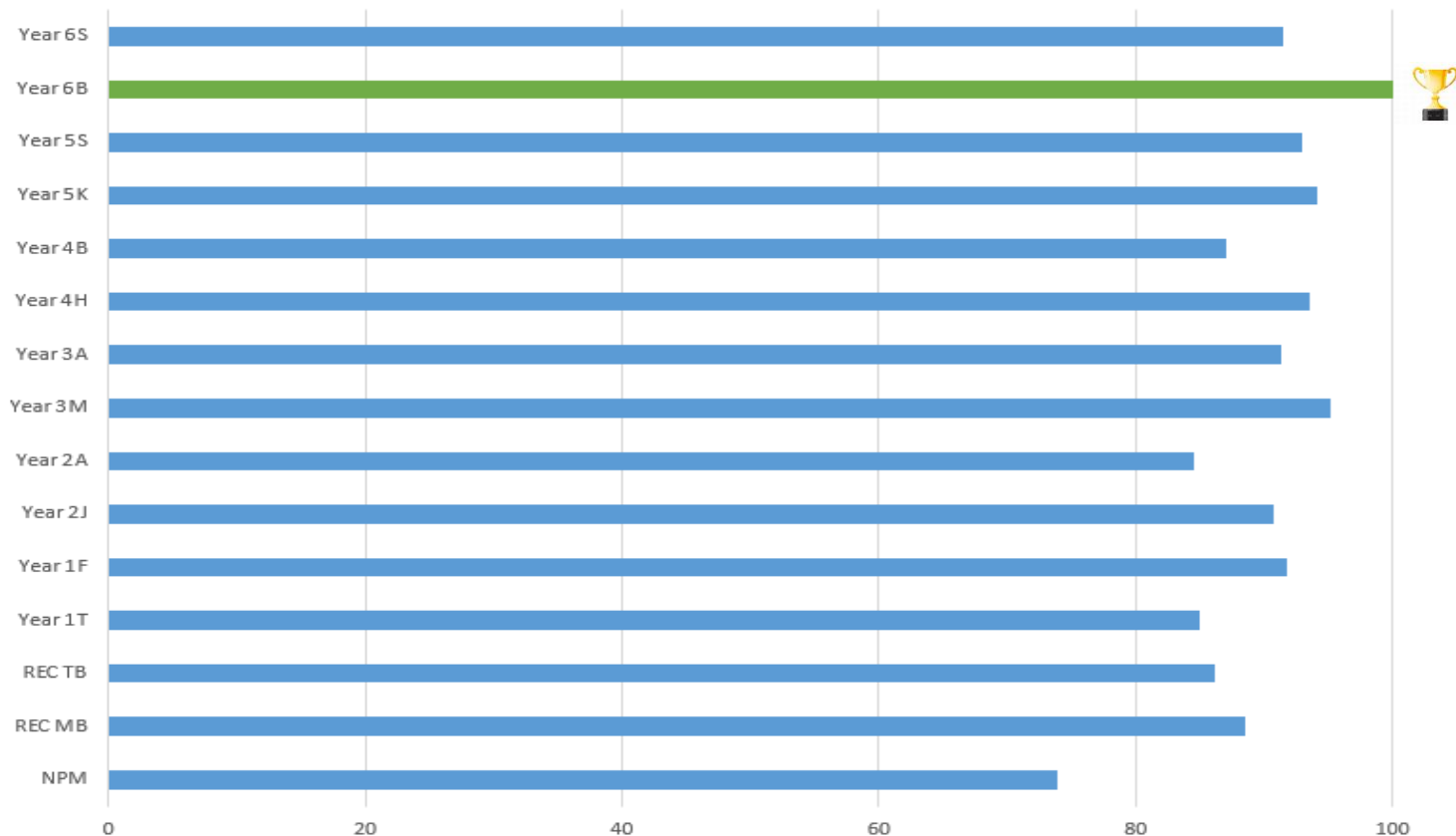
Thank you to the staff who have had to adapt to lots of new rules and procedures and who have been playing a huge part in settling the children into their new classes and new routines.
