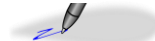
Welcome back to all the classes that have returned this week. We are looking forward to welcoming back Year 2 on Monday 23rd and 6B on Wednesday 25th November.

LINK CORRIDOR DISPLAY



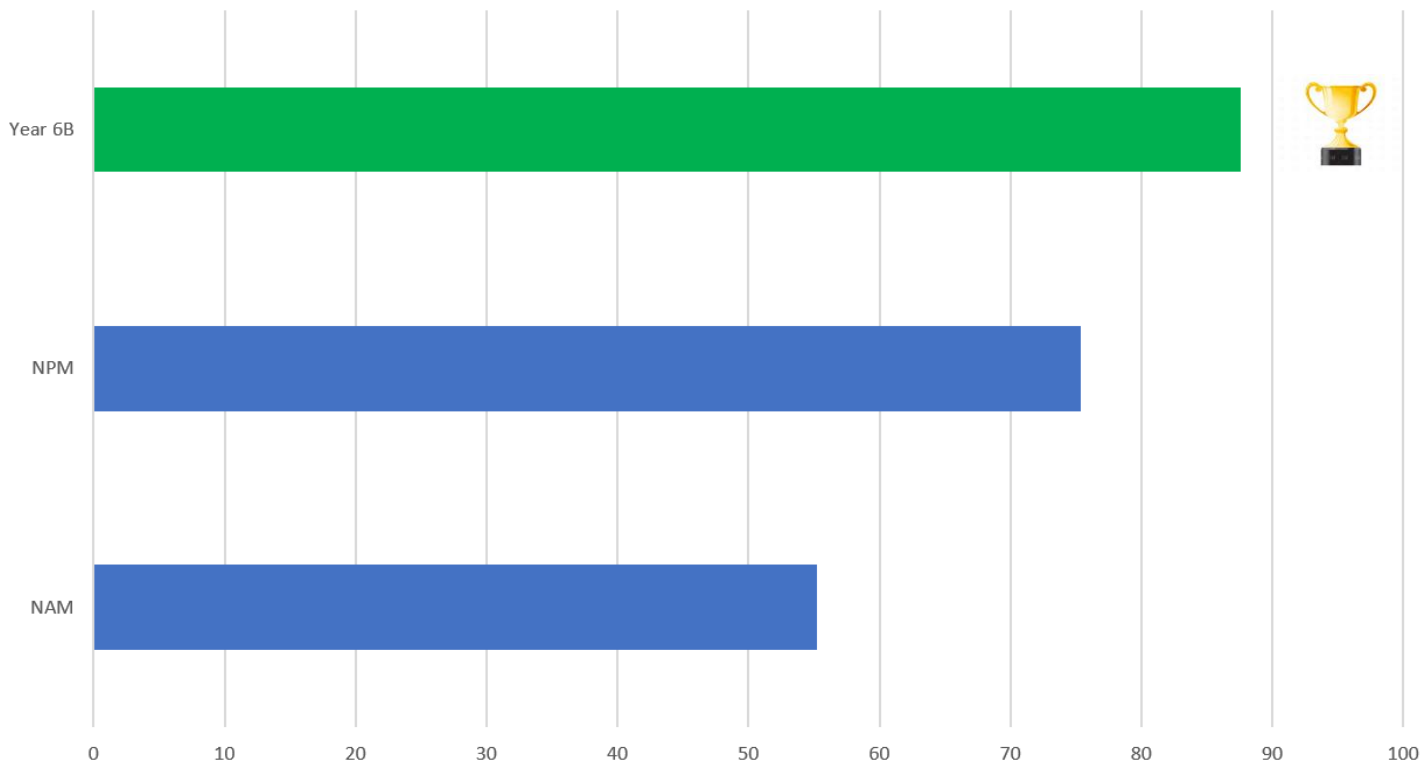
