After school football club will be starting next week for Years 3 – 6. A letter has been given to the children, please sign the permission slip and return to school by **Tuesday 21st September**,

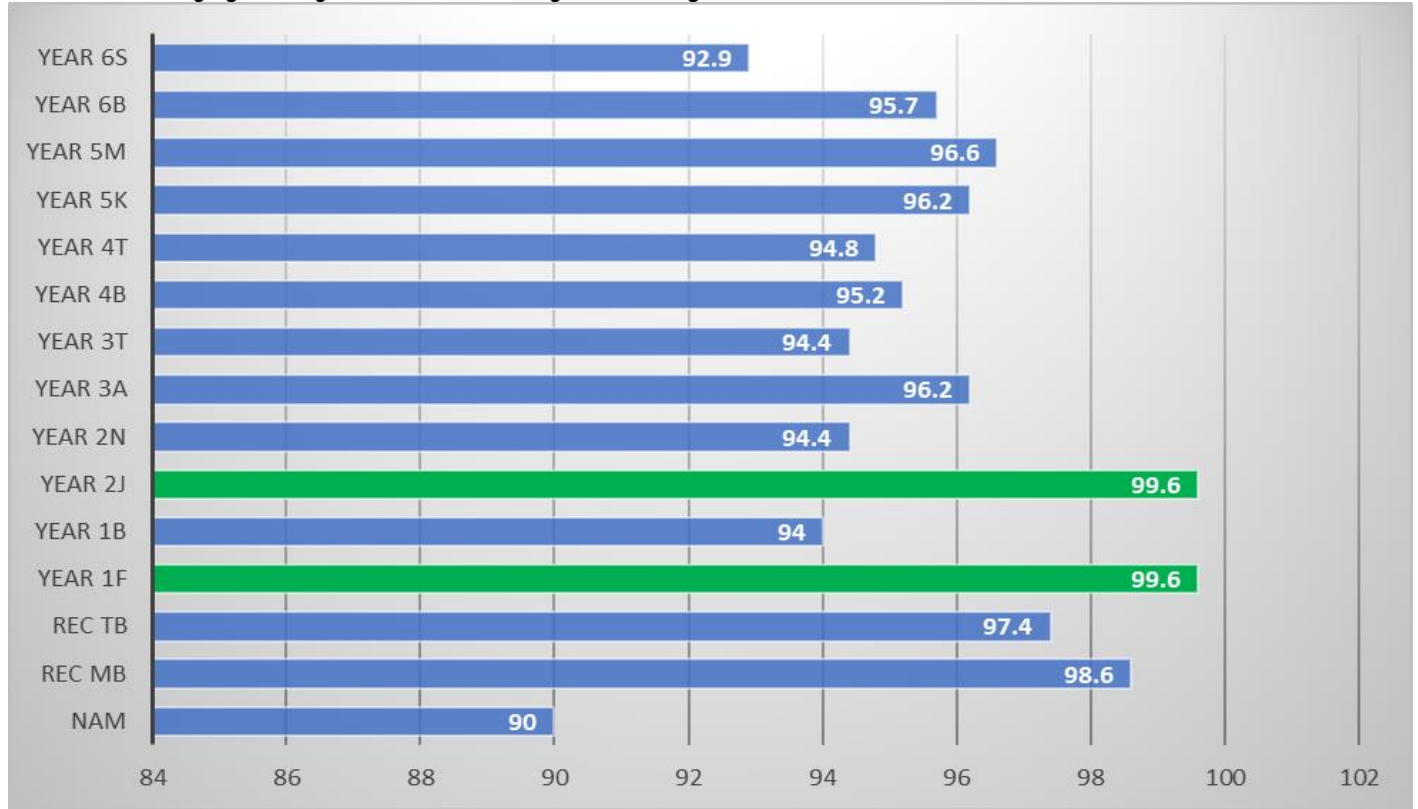
