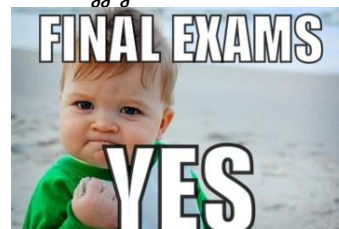
## Reading Picnics

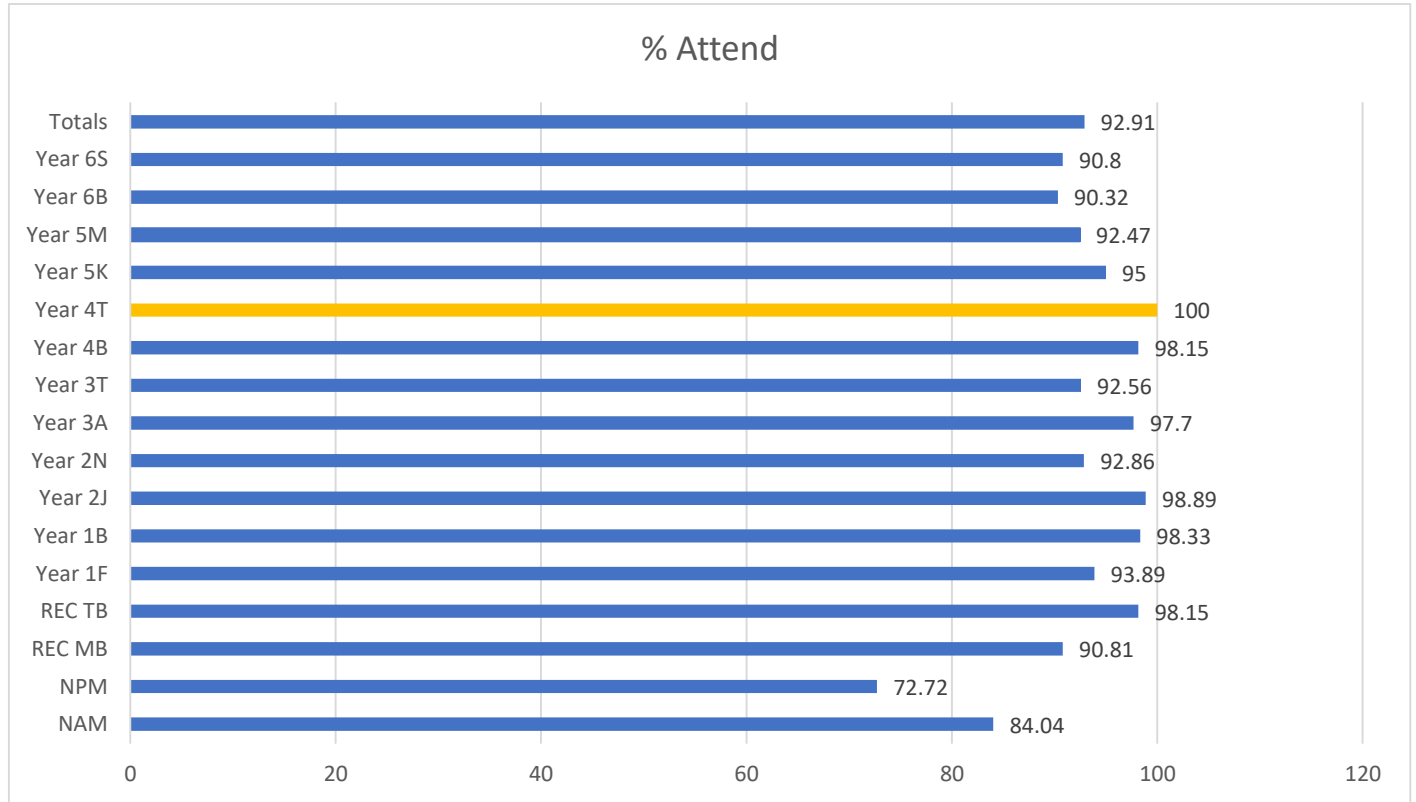
## WELL DONE!
