Uniform procedures

Purpose

Our policy on school uniform is based on the belief that school uniform:

- promotes a sense of pride in our school;
- helps to create a sense of community and belonging towards the school;
- identifies the children with the school;
- supports our commitment to inclusion;
- prevents children from wearing 'fashion clothes' that could be distracting in class;
- ° is practical, smart and designed with health and safety in mind;
- ° is considered good value for money by most parents;

The Role of Parents


We believe that one of the responsibilities of parents is to ensure that their child has the correct uniform and P.E kit, and that it is clean, in good repair and that the child's name is clearly written on all items.

School Uniform

Know that school uniform consists of-

- Dark grey or black trousers or skirt (knee length), white shirt, white blouse or polo shirt, red sweatshirt/ cardigan with or without the school logo and black, flat shoes. (No joggers or leggings are allowed)
- Dark grey or black shorts or red check dresses can be worn in the warmer weather.
- Headscarves should be plain white, red or black.
- Know that all shirts must be tucked in and jumpers either on or off not tied around waists.
- Know that long hair must be tied back for P.E and no lines in hair or extreme haircuts are allowed.
- No false or painted nails are allowed.





SENSIBLE BLACK SCHOOL SHOES SHOULD BE WORN AT ALL TIMES. NO TRAINERS ARE ALLOWED. DURING COLD WEATHER BLACK ANKLE BOOTS MAY BE WORN BUT THEY MUST BE PLAIN.

In wet weather, children can arrive in wellington boots but have their school shoes with them to change into.

PE Kit

- Black shorts or black tracksuit bottoms, red polo shirts, trainers for outside.
- A plain red or black sweatshirt can also be worn in colder months.
- Know that indoor PE is done in black pumps.
- Headscarves should only be worn for P.E if they are small and safe.

Jewellery

Know that, on health and safety grounds, we do not allow pupils to wear jewellery in school except for earring studs in pierced ears, small objects of religious significance and a watch. No piercings are allowed anywhere other than in the ears.

No smart watches are allowed and small and plain hair accessories only.
