Attendance at Caldmore Primary is 94.8% which is just below National average!

Please continue to support us throughout the academic year by making sure your child attends school **every day** unless they are really poorly.

Remember to call the office <u>each day</u> your child is absent and try to show medical evidence where possible, for the absence to be authorised.

More than 5 days of unauthorised absences will lead to a fixed penalty of £80 per parent, per child.

This is in the government guidelines, and we ,as a school, enforce it.

If your child is not in school for more than two days, it is our policy to visit your child at home. This visit will be conducted by a member of staff, or someone from Walsall Council.

Secondary Applications for September 2025

The deadline for applying for a secondary school place for your child is approaching.

All year 6 children should have applied to their preferred choice for September 2025 via Walsall council website.

If you apply late, you may not get a place at one of your preferred schools.
