#### **ATTENDANCE**

A very warm welcome back to all of our pupils and parents after a nice long summer break.

Our whole school attendance is off to a great start at 95.4%. Can we please make sure we keep this going.

May I remind all parents our school expectations in regards to attendance. Children <a href="MUST">MUST</a> be in school everyday they can.

If your child is unwell a parent must ring the office before 9am each morning to inform school of your child's absence.

Proof of any medical appointment will need to be shown at the school office.

A reminder all leave of absence for holidays etc will <u>NOT</u> be authorised and may incur a fine.



#### **Domestic Abuse Walsall Service (DAWS)**

DAWS is accessible to all people who have experienced domestic abuse and need safe accommodation to leave the situation. They welcome referrals from anyone regardless of family size, gender, sexual orientation, languages spoken, No Recourse to Public Funds, or any background.

The service provides emergency short-term accommodation for men and women, with or without children, who are escaping abuse. The service includes a refuge for mainly single females and females with young children (1 of these units is accessible for those with physical disabilities). There are also 2/3 bed houses and flats across the borough which supports those who find it difficult to live in refuge accommodation, or service users such as those who are male, families with older male children, LGBTQ+ or those from ethnic minority groups.

Referrals can be made by any support agency, services such as the councils homelessness team, GP, social services or the police. Customers can also self-refer.
