Our assembly was all about a strong start to our Spring term—being proud to be part of the Caldmore community, proud to wear our uniform and proud to be at school every day.


The last two weeks have seen children collect signatures on

ATTENDANCE

We are at 95.2% year to date as a whole school. We are in a good place for our attendance but there is more to do to reach our target of 97% and above.

A reminder that children should be in school for every day that it is open. Minor illnesses such as coughs and colds are not a reason to keep children off school.

Holidays are not permitted during term time the law is very clear on this, if children are off school due to holiday or extended leave of absence this will be subject to fine.

Safeguarding

This weeks focus: Road Safety

As part of our safeguarding and PSHE curriculums, children engage in specific Road Safety work and activities. We also advise these messages are reinforced at home so together we can ensure our pupils are fully educated on this essential part of personal safety:



Key Messages

- **Manage distractions:** minimise talking/no texting/no looking at technology/ no listening to music on the roadside
- **When travelling inside a vehicle,** always wear your seatbelt and do not cause distractions to the driver
- **Remember the Green Cross Code—** Find a safe place to cross, (ideally a pedestrian crossing), stop before the kerb, look both ways and listen for traffic. When it is safe cross the road and continue to look around for traffic
- **Make sure you are seen!** On dark evenings and mornings, wear something bright or reflective.

A number of clubs finish at 4pm, with a few of the sports clubs and longer activities, like cooking, running until 4:20pm.


Clubs change every half term. The current clubs will finish on the last week of this half term and new clubs will start after the half term holiday. ALL parents need to apply for places at clubs every half term.
